Itinerary:

Meet at Asulkan parking lot at 10 AM.
Follow old railway bed to historical site, follow the trail to Meeting of the Waters bridge, continue on Sir Donald trail and stop before first avalanche area. Lunch at turnaround point below Mt. Sir Donald. Approximately distance 5 km each way.
Depending on weather and snow conditions we may return by crossing the Illecillewaet River and follow Great Glacier trail back.

Required Items to Bring:

Snowshoes (a few are available from trip lead upon request), warm/appropriate clothing. Food & drink for lunch.

Recommended Items to Bring:

Clothing appropriate for weather conditions on the day and any required personal items, such as hiking poles.

How to Get There:

Event Directions: Approximately 65 km east of Revelstoke on Highway #1.
Parking lot is on the south side of the highway.

Notes:

Outing may be canceled if road and weather conditions are bad. Participants would be notified by e-mail or phone call by 9 AM day of the outing.

National Parks parking permit is required to park at Asulkan parking lot.

Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

It is recommended that parents also accompany children under 18.

Participants should be comfortable with moderate outdoor physical activity lasting about 5 hours.

All participants MUST sign 2019 version of ACC Waiver (form will be provided to participants).
